

2019-20 Otto Springman Memorial Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The German American Club of Sarasota (GASCoS) has established the Otto Springman Memorial Scholarship Fund to honor and further the education of persons who plan to continue his/her German studies selected by the GASCoS Scholarship Selection Committee pursuant to the following criteria.

The award is presented by the GASCoS Scholarship Selection Committee. Funding for the program comes from the annual Sommerfest Celebration hosted by the GASCoS. Scholarship awards range from \$200 to more than \$500 based on the applicant's academics, letters of recommendation, proof of current enrollment in German classes, extracurricular activities, research paper and essay.

ELIGIBILITY

German Studies

We seek to promote the study of the German language and participation in German cultural activities. It is in Otto Springman's memory that our GASCoS Scholarship Selection Committee will provide a scholarship to deserving students who plan to continue his/her German studies at an accredited college or community college.

Residency

To be eligible for this award, the applicant must be from Sarasota/Manatee County, but may be going to school out of state or out of the country.

Scholastic Standing - First time applicants

Applicants applying as entering freshman must have been accepted as a full-time student, as defined by that institution, at an accredited college or community college and must have maintained a scholastic grade point average 3.0 or better for the two (2) years of high school study preceding their application, as well as current enrollment in German studies. If a first-time applicant is currently enrolled in college, he/she must have carried a minimum of ten (10) hours credit or equivalent and have maintained a cumulative 3.0 grade point average and show current enrollment in German studies.

Scholastic Standing - Applicants who have previously received an Otto Springman Memorial scholarship

Applicants must have carried a minimum of ten (10) credit hours (or full time equivalent in post-graduate programs), have maintained a cumulative 2.67 grade point average, and show current enrollment in German studies.

All applicants shall provide documentation of the institution's letter grade equivalency for any grade point averages submitted.

APPLICATIONS

All applications and other required materials must be received at the GASCoS Post Office Box by June 28, 2019 (not just postmarked) in order to be considered for the 2019-2020 academic year.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

First-time applicants and applicants who have not previously been awarded an Otto Springman memorial scholarship, must furnish one (1) letter of recommendation. Letter should address the student's scholastic ability, character and worthiness to receive a merit award and be from one of the following: (a) a professor or teacher; (b) an employer; (c) an advisor from a volunteer or extracurricular activity; or (d) a coach from a sport in which you were an athlete.

Letter of recommendation should be sent directly to the German American Social Club of Sarasota by the author or in a sealed envelope signed by the author over the seal. All letters must be received by June 28, 2019 (not just postmarked) or the application is considered incomplete and will not be reviewed by the selection committee.

TRANSCRIPTS

Entering freshmen (high school graduate as of July 1): A copy of the student's transcript for the preceding two (2) years of high school must be included.

College sophomore (freshman year completed as of July 1): A copy of the student's college spring semester grades. If the applicant is not a previous recipient of this scholarship also include a copy of the high school transcript.

All others: A copy of the student's college transcript(s), including spring semester grades.

Transcripts must be received no later than June 28, 2019 (not just postmarked) or the application is considered incomplete and will not be reviewed by the selection committee.

A PURPOSE STATEMENT (250 – 500 words)

All first-time applicants and applicants who have not previously been awarded an Otto Springman memorial scholarship, shall complete a purpose statement on the importance of learning a second language, such as German. The paper must be submitted in typed form and double spaced. See additional requirements on the topic list on page 7.

The purpose statement is optional for previous Otto Springman memorial scholarship award recipients. Applicants who do not submit a purpose statement will be limited to an award of less than \$500. To be considered for an award greater than \$500 the applicant must complete the purpose statement and have a minimum GPA of 2.8. Please note: Submitting a purpose statement does not guarantee scholarship award will exceed \$500. Please see the approved topic list for previous recipient purpose statement and requirements.

A BRIEF ESSAY (250-500 words)

All applicants must write a brief essay which shall be submitted in typed form and double spaced.

First-time applicants and applicants who have not previously been awarded an Otto Springman memorial scholarship, write on what you consider your greatest accomplishment or life-changing experience so far.

Previous recipients, evaluate a significant experience, achievement, risk you have taken, or ethical dilemma you have faced within the past year and its impact on you.

* Purpose statement and/or brief essay may be typed in German or English.

AWARDS

The GASCoS Scholarship Selection Committee shall base its awards upon scholastic achievement, character and worthiness.

Awards shall be transmitted to the academic institution for the spring semester of study. Failure to request the funds within 45 days of the announcement of the awards may be grounds for forfeiture of the award. Any excess award funds must be returned to the German American Social Club of Sarasota within the year received.

The Scholarship Selection Committee may require first-time award recipient to attend a designated German American Social Club of Sarasota Event to receive his or her award. The committee may also request that they be thanked in German.
